- I. Welcome
- II. Presidents Updates Laura Buccola
  - a. Field of Dreams: submitted to NJ Dept of Planning; thank you to John Flack
  - b. Field use fees update: meeting with all sports presidents with DCP, Town engineer and talked through the \$20/athlete fee and how it will be spent going forward; this meeting hasn't happened in 2 to 3 years (\$20/student since 2005); Note that there is a potential for the fee to raise to \$30 in the future.
  - c. Youth umpire kickoff: Thank you to Laura Lameo and Elizabeth Ryan 3/28 for 7<sup>th</sup> graders to umpire 4t/5<sup>th</sup> grade rec
  - d. Bat Boy Program: Thank you to Kate Moon for running this: 3 bat boys for all home high school games; 7<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> graders
  - e. Zotti honoring discussion: likely will honor her on opening day weekend (at Jefferson); one idea was to turn on lights at first home night game
- III. Treasurer's Report Laura Buccola on Drew Spitzers behalf working on tax return; travel budgets have been submitted for 12u teams, tournaments etc.
- IV. Fields update Chris Moon
  - Replacing all lights at Jefferson Field with new LED lighting and new lights in batting cages – EB approved; will take about 5 days and ideally do it the week of spring break; discussions about BOE responsibility going forward
  - Installment of batting cage netting, OF fencing, dugout screens at Wilson, Memorial 60/90 and Myrtle - Thank you to Tom Capparaso for helping with this
  - c. Spring Clean-Up date: 3/18 or 3/19 3/19 likely the better date
  - d. Scoreboard updates for Long and Wilson (city fields): working on getting issues repaired (electrical) and Long Field (DCP) reaching out to the company that

installed it to see about replacement (scoreboard \$5K and then installation is \$7k ish) – replacing or moving scoreboard (rewiring and extending the electric)

- e. Coordinate with LD's to distribute keys: Chris Moon needs # of coaches so he can make new keys for everyone (hope to distribute at Pizzafest); also need access to the restrooms (10u travel and 4<sup>th</sup> grade rec)
- f. Summit Hardware will do overhaul on all tractors etc.
- g. SSBL met with DCP to fill in any lips in the field and where to mow lawns etc.
- V. Softball Travel Update Tim Yarnall on behalf of Jason Filiberti
  - a. Registration recap (coaches, teams): all teams have to be done by tomorrow;
    10u done (not expanded roster) ; 12u (team formation because 2 teams); total 3 teams (1 10u and 2 12u); 8u tough for their age group (double headers on Sundays); working through coaches; working with Drew to finalize budget; Hershey tournament right now only 1 team registered; going forward we may finalize summer registration soon than historically rather than later so that these issues can be addressed; intent is to have an 8u summer team
- VI. Softball Update Tim Yarnall
  - Registration recap/Spring season recap: 295 total versus 310 perhaps will get those kids between now and Pizzafest; very high numbers in K and 1<sup>st</sup>; big concern is from 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> where there is a drop; unforms are ordered; sponsors set (Thank you Alison!!)
  - b. Pizzafest: Uniforms should be in before Pizzafest; gathering give aways for Pizzafest (gift cards, lessons, McCools gift cards, squishmallow) etc; League Directors doing an awesome job – Sam Conroy all set with T-Ball, Libby Jois– 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> and Anush Gulati with 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup>
- VII. Baseball Travel Update Matt Schwark
  - a. 12u Teams updates: sending 2 teams to Cooperstown July 22 to Aug 2<sup>nd</sup>; Pete Soccodato and Andy Smith leading that
  - b. 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Team update (discuss 8<sup>th</sup> grade for next year): current 7<sup>th</sup> grade there are between 30 and 35 kids that will be in 8<sup>th</sup> grade and interested in playing 8<sup>th</sup> grade; those are high numbers and therefore looking to have 2 teams and a second coach; this is something we need to think about now; logistics of that are complicated because not a lot of B teams out there; some towns (Cranford) have 2 teams but b/c they have 2 middle schools; looking for coaches (paid position); 7<sup>th</sup> grade team NOT doing new uniforms because in 8<sup>th</sup> grade has different unforms (not personalized)
  - c. Baseball Travel Committee Meeting Recap: none as of now
- VIII. Baseball Update Pat McGovern
  - a. Registration, draft recap (coaches, teams) Rec evaluations and draft went well; evaluations for Omaha, March 18<sup>th</sup> and may need volunteers; Omaha draft will be that evening; 507 overall (530 last year); T -ball has 137 players which is a huge amount; going forward one buddy request and only for younger teams; League directors are doing an awesome job-thank you; working through glitch with Team Snap; a little behind on equipment but good shape on uniforms because we are going to need to even it out (hoping to have smaller # teams)
